- If you have any questions or if something changes throughout this process and you are no longer able to give, please contact the Catholic Charities staff member that reached out to you, and email AAF@ccdenver.org.
- In order to preserve both client and donor confidentiality, donors are not allowed to meet or communicate directly with the clients and vice versa. The staff contact can, however, facilitate communications and gift distribution.

2. **Don't have time to shop? We'll shop for you! Make a financial gift or buy a gift card (or two!) and we'll do the shopping for you!**

When shopping for your adopted family, please provide:

- **NEW**, unwrapped gifts in large bags, clearly marked with the family name AND number. Example: "John R. (912)". Please label each bag or individual item you bring with the family name and number. Inside the bag as well - It helps to have the name of the recipient on the individual gifts if possible. Please avoid boxes if at all possible. **PLEASE INCLUDE GIFT RECEIPT(S)!** This will help in the rare situation an exchange needs to be made.
- Wrapping paper or gift bags, tape, etc. along with the unwrapped gifts. Our adult clients appreciate the opportunity to wrap the gifts for the children themselves; however, if you would like to place the adult gifts in gift bags, that is absolutely fine!
- You are **NOT** required to purchase every item on this list, but we do ask you provide something for every person on the list. Please provide at least ONE gift item per family member (we want everyone in each family to receive at least one item, even if it is a gift card).

If you are dropping off gifts Tuesday, December 10th:

- We will provide a way to electronically complete a gift submission for your tax purposes
- To help with congestion and unloading, please make sure gifts are clearly labeled with the family name and number
